## In 2016 the charity funded:

- In Tiplyang – school supplies, meals and teachers' salaries.
- In the neighbouring village of Banduk – school meals.
- Through the charity Nepal Wireless, work began on upgrading the internet connection to the school and village.
- In September, working with the Gurkha Welfare Service, essential school supplies were distributed to students whose homes had been destroyed by floods. The children were housed and fed at school for several weeks while their homes were rebuilt.
