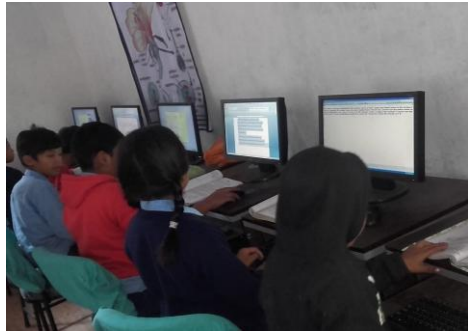
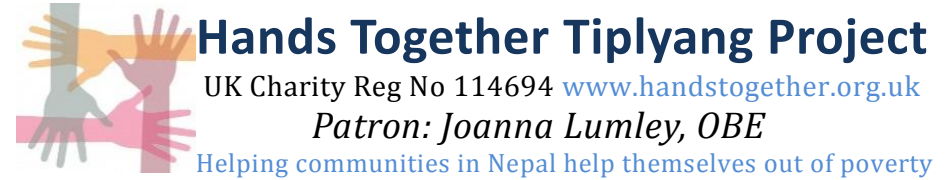




The teachers train in the Montessori method of education and encourage creative learning and collaborative play.

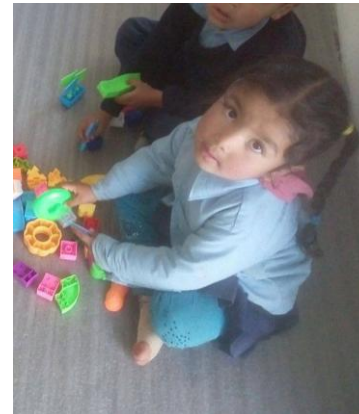


The new computer room and upgraded broadband enables remote learning.
