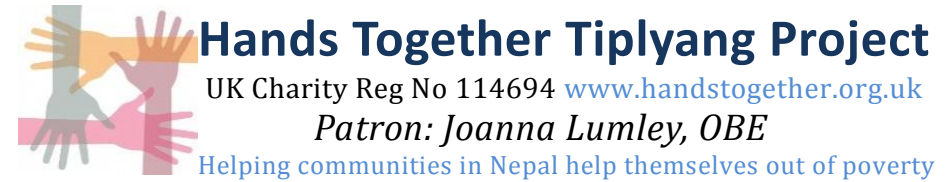




By reallocating existing spending on school meals we were able to fund the introduction of tiffin at Dosalle primary school
